USES LESS WATER

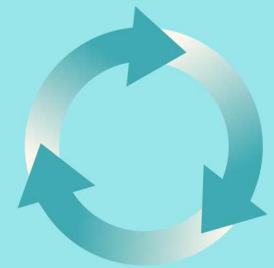
Washing your car at home uses an average amount of 80-140 gallons of drinkable water. Gleam uses less than 15 gallons of fresh water per car. That's 85% less water compared to washing your car at home or at a hand wash.

REUSES MORE WATER

Gleam is more than just a car wash; it's a mini water treatment plant. With 6 reclamation tanks, Gleam treats 100% of the water it uses to wash cars and is able to reuse 90% of the treated water on the next car.

- H** ▶ When you wash your car at home, untreated chemicals go into the storm water system.
- 2** ▶ These chemicals kill fish and other wildlife by polluting our waters.
- O** ▶ Rain on your dirty car can also be harmful because it washes dirty water into the storm water system.
