
HOW TO BUILD BETTER CAR WASHES

how much water does the average car wash use?





USES LESS WATER

Washing your car at home uses an average amount of 80-140 gallons of drinkable water. Gleam uses less than 15 gallons of fresh water per car. That's 85% less water compared to washing your car at home or at a hand wash.





REUSES MORE WATER
